- Maintaining communication with the attending physician and with other health disciplines.
- Educating family members and caregivers with regard to the condition and the OT intervention.
- Developing and maintaining quality improvement statistics and indicators.
- Communicate to appropriate referral sources and stakeholders.

As an Occupational Therapist within our team, you will have a hands-on leadership role in promoting and implementing the role of occupational therapy. You will strive to create a positive and pleasant environment in the Resident's home by working collaboratively and respectfully with all care partners including residents, co-workers, families, physicians, community and professional agencies. In everything you do, you will strive to enhance and strengthen the groups and individuals who live and work at the Windsor Elms Village.
