Unaccompanied Leave Policy



Windsor Elms Village has introduced a new process to support both resident independence and safety when residents leave the home for outings without staff. Our nursing team will record when a resident leaves, who they are with, and their expected return time. If a resident does not return as expected, staff will follow up with the resident or their contact to ensure everything is okay. This approach helps us balance resident choice and privacy with our guiding principle that safety is paramount.

Circle of Support - Family & Friends of WEV Residents

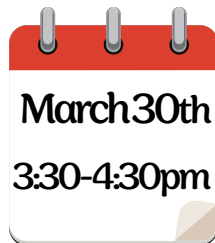

Understanding the role of a POA, how to name someone to make healthcare decisions, why having a Will matters, and what happens if someone dies without one can bring peace of mind and help you feel prepared when unexpected decisions arise.
